October 26, 2020

- 9:00 Call to order. Chairman Rein and Commissioner Hammeke in attendance
- Handed out: Payroll, payable vouchers, final minutes for 9/14, draft minutes for 9/21, Email from Blue Cross/Blue Shield, Copy of agreement for services SDSI
- Rein received an email from KS Democratic Party about advance voting instructions not correct.
- Reviewed the information received from Blue Cross/Blue Shield about increase in premiums. BC/BS will be at Nov. 2 meeting to answer questions. Commissioners agreed it would be helpful to have the Health Audit before they work on the budget.
- Rein will not sign any checks until County Clerk Searight has signed them.
- Rein and McNett have negotiated with Pam Ptacek on bill for services in the County Clerk's Office. A new voucher needs to be made out. The commissioners are agreeable with her continuing her work, if necessary.
- Commissioner Lewis joined the meeting.
- The Ballot Box on the West side of the Court House was removed on request of Rein.
- TamI Keenan was asked to bring in her Clerk's Report.
- 10:00 Tina Keeler from the Appraisers Office joined the meeting to discuss applications for the open position in her office. **Lewis moves to go into an executive session from 10:00 to 10:05 for personnel matters with Tina Keller in attendance. Hammeke seconds. Passed (3-0).**
- 10:05 Resume regular session. No action taken
- Sheriff Scott King joined the meeting. He was asked if he had met with the people from INA alert about Security and Surveillance . Will look into it. Also brought in two vehicle titles that needed signatures.
- Hammeke moves to purchase thru Comfort Systems a Mitsubishi Air Conditioner for the Court Offices as presented. Rein seconds. Passed (2-0). Lewis abstains.**
- 11:00 Gail Antenen on phone ( in quarantine) and Jessica Moore in attendance to present the Quarterly Reports for Community Corrections.
- Received a quote from Nex-Tech. Commissioners said they would be receiving bids next week from INAAalert out of Ellinwood for security systems at Annex, Court House and Sheriff's Office.
- For Court Year 2020 all reports (adult, Juvenile, Reinvestment) match to the Treasurer's Report . They are still waiting for checks to be voided by the County Clerk's Office .
- Lewis moves to accept quarterly cash reconciliation and certification Report - Adult services for Quarter Ending September 30, 2020 as presented. Hammeke seconds. Motion passes (3-0).**
- Lewis moves to accept quarterly cash reconciliation and certification Report Juvenile Services for Quarter ending September 30, 2020 as presented. Hammeke seconds. Motion passes (3-0).**
- Lewis moves to accept quarterly cash reconciliation Report – Reinvestment – for Quarter ending September 30, 2020 as presented. Hammeke seconds. Passes (3-0).**

Will need three copies of each report. Gail will sign on Friday.

**Lewis moves to match the \$2,600.00 collected in the Alcohol Tax Fund for a total of \$5,200.00 to offset budget shortfalls. Money comes out of special alcohol fund. Hammeke seconds. Passed (3-0).**

Jessica asked if they needed to pay rent on the basement classroom of the Annex if they were not using it? Asked her to check with Joel.

**Lewis moves to approve "Agreement for Services" with Southwest Developmental Services SDSI – for Jan. 1, 2021 to Dec. 31, 2021-for the sum of \$19,600.00 as presented. Hammeke seconds. Passes(3-0). Attested by Aimee Norris, Deputy. Four copies will be needed.**

Tami Keenan, Treasurer, brought in her Clerk's Report up to October 13 for Commissioners to review.

11:30 Alex Filbert from the Chamber of Commerce introduced Chelsea Miller, a new employee. Friday, December 4<sup>th</sup> will be the 100<sup>th</sup> Christmas Parade. It will be in the evening, with a tree lighting and shopping downtown. There will be no Santa House.

Asked permission from the Commissioners to allow a tree to be put up on the Court House grounds and to have it lit on Dec. 4<sup>th</sup>. The tree will be donated by Delp Christmas Tree Farm. Consent given. Suggested she check with Tim on how to put up the tree.
