9:00 Reconvene. Pelton, Bowman and Haas present.

Went thru mail.

Ruth Searight, County Clerk. Gave Commissioners the following for their review/approval: Star Communication bill; Raymond Bauer Insurance notice of non-renewal date of January 9, 2015, of Public Employees Faithful Performance Blanket Positive Bond; Ks. Labor Law Poster Service; payables; payroll; wage/salary update, and the information to call for a new delinquent tax sale on real estate.

**Approved Star Communication Bill of \$468.00.**

Mark Bauer, VonFeldt, Bauer & VonFeldt and John Settle, County Attorney/ County Counselor. Discussed the necessary signatures needed for the 2013 Pawnee County Audit. Bauer told the Commissioners it was appropriate for them as a Board to approve the Chair signing the document "For the Board." Bauer said the County Attorney signing the document was appropriate, as he also served as the Commissioners County Counselor. However, we are now late on getting the Final Audit to Moody's.

John Settle, County Attorney. Discussed the three bills for an autopsy that he had previously said not to pay. After visiting with the vendors and the Deputy District Coroner, he now felt that Pawnee County needed to pay them. **Commissioners approved paying the three bills.**

11:00 Paul Carrington, PVCH, Inc., Chief Nursing Officer. Presented and discussed 340 B Program that is handled by the Office of Pharmacy Affairs. It is to help low income and indigent persons.

We have just now become eligible for the program because we now have the Rural Health Clinic designation, and the hospital is owned by the County. Carrington explained how the program worked.

The form the Commissioners need to sign certifies the hospital is owned by the County. We have just a 15 day window of opportunity to apply.

**Motion by Pelton, seconded by Haas, that if County Attorney John Settle, approves paperwork, the Chair may signed the form.**

**Unanimous.**

Bowman and Carrington went to see John Settle to see if it is okay to sign.

Bowman returned, and said Settle needed more information before he could approve.
