**Motion by Caplinger, seconded by Bowman, Concurred by Pelton, for Rziha to make application for Grant, and if Pawnee County receives the grant, Rziha will be out of office one day per week for June, July and August, visiting the other ten counties implementing the grant.**
- Kurt Demel, Co. Hwy. Adm. Presented, discussed and **Commissioners approved the Agreement with KDOT, for Pawnee County to control the Noxious Weeds.**  
Gave update on mowing.
