


**September 9, 2010

- Kearney lead a discussion on identifying issues affecting Pawnee County,
and who are the agency's/departments/entities we need to deal with on
the issues.
Some of the issues identified were: State Facilities; Health Care Hospital
(Health Reform); Re-districting (re-apportionment) of State and National
Districts; Transportation; Education; Work Comp Reform; Energy; Law
Enforcement; Fire Protection and Communication.
Some of the agency's/departments/entities we will need to deal with on
issues are: Legislature; KDHE; KHPA (Kansas Health Policy Authority);
EPA; KBI/Lab; Fire Marshall; DOC; SRS; JJA; KDOE; Board of Regents;
TEA (Technical Education Authority); DOL; KCC; FCC; AG; and
Governor.

paper" to give to lawmakers, stressing our efficiencies, desires and needs.
Each person wrote down their top three priorities for Pawnee County and
gave them to Kearney.
