9:03 Meeting was called to order, opened with the pledge of allegiance.

9:00am, proclamation scheduled for today was rescheduled for Monday, May 9, 2022 at 9:00am.

Clerk Rein presented payable vouchers and checks, draft minutes for review and correction.

County Attorney McNett spoke to the Commissioners regarding adjustment of the Zoning Handbook. Discussion took place.

Discussion took place regarding billing township or individuals for proposed road closure publications. County Attorney McNett and Commissioners agreed they may be billed for the publications.

10:00 Tim Taylor, Maintenance Supervisor, Joel Davis, Register of Deeds, Public Information Officers, Assistant Emergency Management Director presented a BID from INA Alert system for the courthouse door locking system. Joel and Tim explained this would include all the doors of the courthouse. currently the courthouse has two doors on a system. With a new system, it would be for all courthouse doors. Discussion took place regarding the current services used by the courthouse.

Motion by Rein, seconded by Hammeke to approve the BID for INA Alert door lock system as presented, to determine remote monitoring at a later time, to include the additional amount for door sensors if necessary to be paid out of Special Project. Motion passes, 3-0.


Tim discussed with the Commissioners tornado drill for County Employees. Commissioners stated to discuss this with Emergency Management Director, Josh Huff.
