

Pawnee County Commissioners
Minutes
August 2, 2021

- Present: Commissioners: Rein, Lewis, Hammeke Clerk Rein.
- 8:05 Meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Clerk Rein presented agenda, Payroll report, Payables Vouchers with checks, revised budget, draft minutes for review and corrections, approved minutes for signature.
- Clerk Rein and the Commissioners began budget discussions.
- Clerk Rein spoke to the Commissioners about a conversation with KCAMP and the insurance coverage of the new ambulance. KCAMP representative stated that they normally don't have much liability with EMS.
- KCAMP suggested either an MOU be signed for the county that would need to have insurance for the ambulance until the transfer of the EMS services after the first of the year or park the ambulance until January when the transfer of EMS will be in effect.
- Clerk Rein did state KCAMP believed the county will see an increase in premiums this upcoming year.
- KCAMP by-laws and interlocal agreement must be recorded in the Register of Deeds office. Clerk Rein asked what fund is to be billed for the recording of the document. Commissioners stated it would come out Commissioners Contractual
- 8:47 Sheriff King, Undersheriff Atteberry and Lieutenant/Emergency Management Huff met with the Commissioners
- Lieutenant Huff explained to the commissioners the Sheriff would like to sell the pick-up on Purple Wave versus trading it in, believing it could bring in more money than the trade-in.
- Sheriff King updated the Commissioners on the search for the sexual predator as well as the happenings over the weekend.
- Budget discussion took place with the Commissioners and the Sheriff's department.
- 9:48 Aaron Koehn, VonFeldt Bauer and VonFeldt discussed the budget with the Commissioners and Clerk Rein.
- 10:30 Commissioners recessed to attend the LEPC meeting.

Motion by Rein, seconded by Lewis to approve Juvenile Services Carryover Reimbursement Budget Summary for fiscal year 2022. Motion passes, 2-0.

Commissioner Rein spoke to Gail regarding signatures on all reports for Community Corrections to have Judge Gattermann review and sign all reports before presenting them to the Commissioners.


