\* INCREASE IN ABSENTEEISM RATE IN LOCAL SCHOOLS SHOULD TRIGGER CONVERSATION WITH LOCAL HEALTH OFFICIALS REGARDING NEXT STEPS. (ADA in 2018-19 School Year was 93%)

\*\* THIS MATRIX DOES NOT INCLUDE CONGREGATE POPULATIONS (i.e., LSH RESIDENTS, DOC POPULATIONS, NURSING HOME RESIDENTS).
